A State Pension forecast will show you how much State Pension you could get and the date you can get it.

You cannot get a forecast if you are already getting your State Pension or if you have delayed ('deferred') claiming it.

Your forecast is not a guarantee and is based on the current law. It does not include any increase due to inflation.
